Resident Spotlight Lillian Hauser

Lillian France Hauser was born March 21, 1933 in Dobson, NC to Luther France and Bessie Finney France. She was the second youngest of twelve children.

Lillian's father served in World War I until the "Great War" was over. Through the grace of God he returned home safe and unharmed. He would send his earnings home to his mother to help provide for his 15 siblings. Her father was a hard working farmer and moved the family to Mt. Airy, NC. This is where she joined the church and was baptized at the age of twelve.

Lillian later moved to Tobaccoville, NC and married Wiley Hauser Jr. when she was 18 years old.

Her greatest accomplishment was raising her seven beautiful and successful children, two of which have been called to glory. She instilled morals, values, respect and the love and importance of Jesus in their lives.

Lillian worked for Marvin Gentry, a very affluent builder in King, NC for 47 years. She kept house and raised his children.

She also worked for Dr. Stanley for 27 years with housekeeping and helping to raise his four children until he left King. She never paid a doctors bill for her children when they were sick. She would take them to his house and he would treat them there. She worked taking care of families until she was 83 years of age.

Lillian was the first African American woman elected to the Tobaccoville Town Council and served two terms that totaled eight years. She was instrumental in getting RJ Reynolds to provide Tobaccoville with over \$250,000 a year for over 30 years, which has provided the town with a park and recreation facility.

She was a faithful member of First Baptist Church of King, NC.

Her favorite things to do are reading the Bible, testifying to others, helping others understand God's Word, and watching TCT (Christian television).

One of her favorite bible verses is, "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life"-John 3:16. She lives her life as a testimony of Jesus Christ's love and forgiveness.
